Election Results

At the recent spring election, the positions of Village Trustee #1-Public Works, Trustee #2- Wastewater and Treasurer were on the ballot. Only 61 of the 188 registered voters in North Bay voted. Rick Cermak and Bob O'Brien are staying on as Trustee #2 and Treasurer respectively. Resident Dave Arvai, a newcomer to the board, ran uncontested and is our new Village Trustee#1-Public Works. Please thank these board members for stepping up and congratulate them on their positions. They will formally take office at the Village board meeting on April 14, 2014.

Yard Waste

Yard waste pick up runs from the first Monday in April to the last Monday in November. Please have your yard waste at the curb by 7:00 a.m. on Mondays **beginning April 7.** As we are using Johns Disposal this year, you may no longer use orange stickers. GREEN stickers are required and can be purchased from any board member at a cost of \$1.00 each. Board members will swap your orange stickers for green stickers at no cost.

Yard waste should be placed in 30 gallon paper bags with a **GREEN STICKER ATTACHED** and **FACING THE STREET.** Bags are available at local hardware stores. You may also use containers such as a plastic trash can for yard waste, but they must be CLEARLY MARKED. If it's not clearly marked as "Yard Waste," the cans may be missed.

Branches smaller than 6 inches in diameter will also be picked up if they are cut in pieces no longer than 4 feet in length and bundled and tied with twine. Bundles should not exceed 60 lbs. in weight or 1 foot in diameter. Bundles MUST also have a green sticker attached.

A Special Note about Grass Clippings...eventually the grass will grow!

Please be sure you do not put any grass clippings or yard waste, tree branches, etc. in the street or on village property. If you have a lawn service, please be sure to pass this onto them as well.

Upcoming Repairs on Nicolet and Hennepin

Expect to see workmen from The Wanasek Corporation later this month working on the Nicolet and Hennepin bridges and extending about 100 ft. down the street in each direction from the bridges.

Ravine Clean-up

Each spring Lisa Scott Ptacek and Molly Buhler organize volunteers to pull garlic mustard, an invasive species, from the ravine before it goes to seed.

We prefer to begin in April while the plants are still small, as soon as it's warm enough to work outdoors. However with this cold unpredictable weather, it's possible the weather won't cooperate until late April/early May.
