Yard Signs

A reminder that our Ordinances state "No advertising sign of any character shall be permitted except for one unlighted sign...pertaining to the lease, hire or sale of the building premises on which the sign is located" (Chapter 8.07(2)(a)). Further definitions are found under Chapter 8.06.

Hazardous Household Waste

Bring your harmful household chemicals to our permanent collection site every third Saturday, 8:00am-1:00pm at 6200 21st Street, just west of Hwy. 31. See the attached flyer for specific dates and restrictions. Medication collection boxes are located at several locations, including Lakeview Pharmacy and Racine Police Department.

What You Should Bring

Household Items

- Artist and hobby paint
- Cooking oil – used
- Floor/wax stripper*
- Fluorescent light bulbs/Compact bulbs (CFLs)
- Metal cleaners
- Mothballs
- Polish/spot remover w/solvent*
- Rechargeable batteries **
- Thermometers w/mercury

Home Improvement

- Adhesives, glues with solvent*
- Cleaners, solvent based
- Concrete cleaner (acid)
- Furniture stripper
- Oil** based paint
- Paint remover or stripper
- Paint thinner/turpentine
- Rust remover
- Varnish
- Wood preservative

Automotive

- Auto body repair products
- Brake fluid
- Carburetor cleaner
- Degreasers
- Gasoline, fuels
- Solvent based car waxes
- Transmission fluid
- Thermostats w/mercury

Yard & Garden

- Driveway sealer
- Fertilizer with weed killer
- Insect or bug killer
- Kerosene
- Lighter fluid
- Motor oil and gas mixtures
- Pool chemicals
- Rat/rodent poison
- Weed killer

* Solvent-containing products have the words: flammable, combustible or contains petroleum distillates on the label. Any products with acetone, xylene and methylene chloride should be saved for collection.


