## **RESOLUTION NO. 2020-1**

## RESOLUTION CHANGING THE NUMBER OF ELECTION OFFICIALS

The Village Board of the Village of North Bay, Racine County, Wisconsin, do resolve as follows:

**WHEREAS**, section 7.32, Wis. Stats., allows a municipal governing body to reduce the required number of election officials at a polling place from 7 or 5, the latter being in a municipality where voting machines are used, to no less than 3; and,

**WHEREAS**, the Village Board has determined that it would be advantageous to the Village to have only as many election officials on duty as are needed for a given election;

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** by the Village Board that there shall be a minimum of 3 election officials on duty at every election; and,

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED** that, at the discretion of the Village Clerk, the requisite number of election officials may be increased for any election. However, the number of election officials working at a given election shall always be an odd number.
