FALL LEAF COLLECTION ON PUBLIC ROADS BEGINS MONDAY, OCTOBER 23<sup>RD</sup>, 2023
Please rake leaf piles to the curb by 7AM Monday. Please, DO NOT mix other yard waste with leaves or it will not be picked up. To allow proper rainwater flow, please maintain a 6 inch gap between the curb and leaf pile. Leaf collection is expected to end in late November, or the first measurable snowfall.
