LETTER FROM THE PRESIDENT

Hello North Bay Neighbors,

In a public comment at last month's Board of Trustees meeting, resident and Planning Commission member Bill Cosban requested that the Board implement a noise ordinance. Bill was speaking for himself, and others, about noise from construction and yard maintenance early in the morning and late in the evening.

The topic of a noise ordinance has been discussed for some time but the Board has been reluctant to pursue it. The Village's location and size creates a peaceful enclave that we've cherished and maintained through mutual respect and consideration. That's been the case for decades and we believe it is the foundation on which we hope can continue. There are also legal fees associated with new ordinances and we all like to keep our taxes as low as possible

A friendly reminder to your neighbor might be all that is needed to raise awareness and fix a potential situation.

You may also schedule an appointment with the Village Clerk to complete a paper absentee ballot application. When registering to vote absentee in person, please bring a valid photo ID.
