GO-CARTS, DIRT BIKES, RIDING OR RIDEABLE MOTORIZED APPARATUS OR ANY OTHER MECHANICAL DEVICE(S) ARE PROHIBITED IN NORTH BAY

In accordance with Chapter 15.02 of the Village of North Bay Code, the operation of any go-cart, dirt bike, riding or rideable motorized apparatus, or other mechanical device—excluding lawn mowers—that is not regulated by the Wisconsin Department of Transportation is prohibited within the Village limits. **This regulation is in place to ensure the**

safety of operators and to protect motorists from potential collisions, particularly when reversing from driveways or navigating obscured corners.

REMINDER, MAINTAIN YOUR CURBS & GUTTERS | To help minimize repair costs and extend the lifespan of our village infrastructure, please maintain the curbs and gutters adjacent to your property.
